



## How To Get Here

### Flying:

The most local airports are Chambéry (94KM), Grenoble (123KM), Geneva (136KM), Lyon (200KM).

### Driving:

There is plenty of parking available outside the chalets so driving is a good option for some guests. If you intend to get a ferry or the Channel Tunnel then we would suggest using a Sat Nav system (or a reliable navigator/co-pilot) to help you with the majority of the journey.

Remember that blue signs in France denote Toll Roads – these are normally the quickest route to take.

**Chalet La Maison**

### From Chambéry

- Take the E70 – following signs for Albertville
- Once at Albertville follow signs for Moutiers (taking the N90)
- Take Sortie 40 off the N90 onto the D117 signposted “St Jean, St Martin, Les Menuires & Val Thorons”
- You’ll pass by Villarby and St Jean de Belleville - La Combe is signposted. It is on the right hand side of the road about a Kilometre after La Flachère.

### From Geneva

From Geneva things are very simple



- Having picked up your hire car you will immediately pick up signs for FRANCE and pass through the border control (passports are not normally required here but sometimes they do perform checks – have it handy just in case)
- Once you are through border control follow signs for Annecy
- When you get closer to Annecy you'll start to pick up signs for Albertville – follow these.
- Once you've passed through Albertville you need to follow signs for Moutiers
- Take Sortie 40 off the N90 onto the D117 signposted "St Jean, St Martin, Les Menuires & Val Thorens"
- You'll pass by Villarby and St Jean de Belleville - La Combe is signposted. It is on the right hand side of the road about a kilometre after La Flachere.

### From Grenoble

- Follow the A41 in the direction of Chambéry
- Follow the A430 to Albertville
- Once at Albertville follow signs for Moutiers (taking the N90)
- Take Sortie 40 off the N90 onto the D117 signposted "St Jean, St Martin, Les Menuires & Val Thorens"
- You'll pass by Villarby and St Jean de Belleville - La Combe is signposted. It is on the right hand side of the road about a kilometre after La Flachere.

### Chalet L'Orcieres

- Follow the A41 in the direction of Chambéry
- Follow the A430 to Albertville
- Once at Albertville follow signs for Moutiers (taking the N90)
- Take Sortie 40 off the N90 onto the D117 signposted "St Jean, St Martin, Les Menuires & Val Thorens"
- Eventually you will reach the turn off St Martin De Belleville. Drive past this main turn off and carry on the road heading towards Les Menuires.
- After a mile or so you will see a sign for Villarabout on the left, follow this sign. Wind your way up through Villarabout keeping left. After a few hundred metres you'll see a sign for La Villard on your left – take it.
- Immediately after that you'll see a sign for La Villard taking you right and down the hill.
- After a few hundred metres the road splits into three, take the right fork up the hill. Chalet L'Orcieres is the last chalet up the hill on the left.



### **Train:**

Moutiers Salins station is 25 minutes drive away from the chalet. It is very well served by TGV services from Paris or directly on the Eurostar from London St Pancras. Once at Moutiers station you can get a taxi up to the chalet or we can come and pick you up (groups of 6 or less – for a small charge of Euro20pp each way)

### **Hiring a car:**

Many guests have found this a very cost effective and hassle free way of getting to the chalet – a comparison site such as <http://www.comparecarhire.co.uk/> might help you find a good deal.

### **Airport Transfers:**

Here you have two options – a private transfer (similar to a taxi) or a shared transfer. Private transfers are considerably more expensive than shared transfers but suit certain guests (ie those with children)
